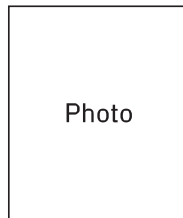

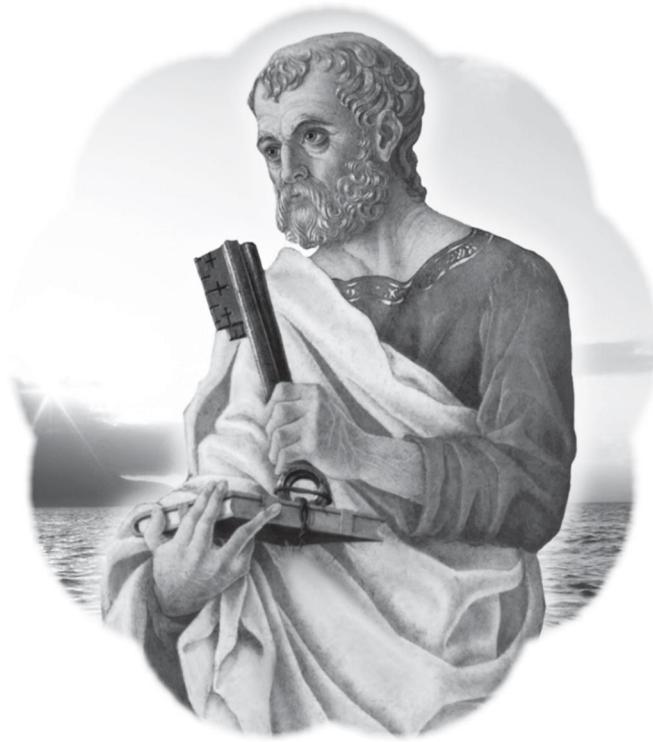

### **St. Peter-Our Heavenly Patron**

St. Peter was born at Bethsaida on the shore of the sea Galilee. He settled down at Capernaum, earned his living by fishing until Jesus called him to “become a fisher of men”.

His name was Simon, but our Lord, on first meeting told him that he should be Kephas, the Aramaic equivalent of the Greek Word whose English form is Peter (i.e. rock). He is the Premier among the twelve disciples, a man of great holiness and meekness. It was he who, as the spokesman of the rest made sublime profession of faith, “You are the Messiah, the Son of the Living God”.

God filled him with true wisdom and knowledge. He preached the first public sermon at Pentecost. There are two books in the Holy Bible to his credit.
