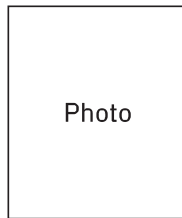

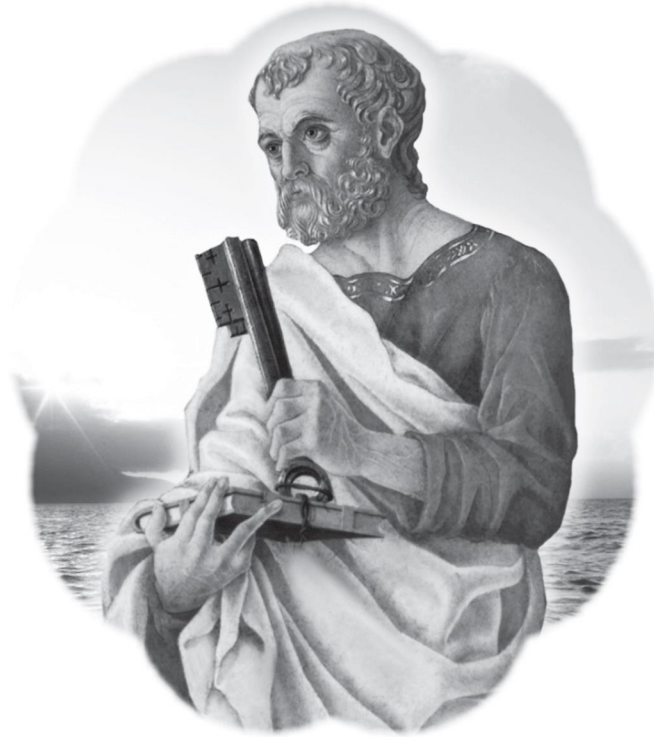

He is the Premier among the twelve disciples, a man of great holiness and meekness.
